Fabricio Lara (Oruro, Bolivia 1966) is based in La Paz, Bolivia. His work is inspired by the primal research of the human being and its ancestral codes. Through symbolic research, the artist creates characters that wander between abstraction and figuration. The study of the reduced palettes of earth and broken colors of pre-Columbian cultures led him to manage temperatures and their atmospheric variations.
